Terminal Improvement: The OST Phase-1 Scope of work consists of improvements to the existing baggage handling systems at Lobbies L2, L3, and L5, L7, and L8, renovations / replacement of Baggage Handling System (BHS). Refer to the drawings for specific scope.

- a. L2 and L3 Centralization of the Lower Level Programmable Logic Controller (PLC) controls in both lobbies.
- b. L5 Replacement of all three (3) outbound make-ups and adjustments of associated feeds and conveyors.
- c. L7 Replacement of two (2) outbound make-ups and associated make-up feed and conveyors.
- d. L8 Replacement of all sortation piers in the Lobby 8 basement with two (2) flat plate and two (2) slope pallet devices. Sortation loop conveyors are replaced with new equipment with the addition of crossovers between the sortation loops; the inductions onto the sortation loops are relocated and updated with new conveyors, manual encoding station is relocated, replacement of lower level controls and the necessary modifications to upper level controls.
- e. Provide protective devices and barriers to the conveyors and equipment from vehicular traffic as indicated on the drawings.

f. L5, L7, and L8 – Provide, associated electrical and telecommunication work, fire protection renovations, fire alarm system upgrades and all other associated work as indicated on the drawings.

To be eligible to bid for award, bidders must possess a valid State of Hawaii General Building "A" license at the time of bidding.

A 5% bid adjustment for bidders that are parties to apprenticeship agreements pursuant to Section 103-55.6, Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS), is applicable to this project.

Compliance with Act 192, SLH 2011 is a requirement for this project whereby a minimum of 80% of the bidder's work force on this project **must** consist of Hawaii residents.
