PROVISION OF FAMILY-CHILD INTERACTION LEARNING PROGRAM SERVICES

The Executive Office on Early Learning (EOEL) through the Hawaii State Department of Education (Department), requests community input to facilitate the planning activities and development of a request for proposal (RFP) for the provision of Family-Child Interaction Learning Program services that support families in taking an active role in the social, emotional, and cognitive development of their young children.

The information received will assist the Department in preparing the release of one or more RFPs in the immediate future. The Department will be seeking vendors with the ability to provide the aforementioned services to identified children in the State of Hawaii. The Department welcomes feedback from any and all prospective vendors to formulate the criteria to compose a competitive solicitation for this service.

As of July 1, 2015, EOEL was permanently attached to the Department for administrative purposes. EOEL will be responsible for administration of contracts resulting from this procurement.
