

NOTICE TO BIDDERS

SEALED BIDS for SHED REPAIRS AT PIER 1, KAHULUI HARBOR, MAUI, HAWAII, JOB H. C. 30193 will be received at the Contracts Office, Department of Transportation, 869 Punchbowl Street, Honolulu, Hawaii 96813, or at the Office of the District Engineer – Maui, 650 Palapala Drive, Kahului, Hawaii 96732, until 2:00 p.m. Hawaii Standard Time, March 5, 2020, at which time and place(s) they will be publicly opened and read. Bids received after said due date and time shall not be considered.

The scope of work for this project consists of performing concrete repairs on walls and column pedestals and repairing a partition wall in the shed at Pier 1 at Kahului Harbor. The estimated construction cost is between \$100,000 and \$250,000.

To be eligible for award, bidders must possess a valid State of Hawaii General Engineering Contractor's "B" license at the time of the bid opening.

Late submittals for this project will not be reviewed by the DOT. A separate SPO Form-38 shall be completed and submitted for each product. Campaign contributions by State and County Contractors. Contractors are hereby notified of the applicability of Section 11-355, HRS, which states that campaign contributions
